There will be nine taught hours per fortnight in the department. Lessons will be based on extending thinking with stretch & challenge tasks, after pre-lesson reading as flipped learning. This allows more time for exam practice.

In year 13, we build upon psychological thinking by covering a few areas in more specific depth, like Relationships & Forensic Psychology. We develop our students' writing skills further with more essaywriting practice and greater research skills.
