








Academic Excellence

- Our Year 13 results had a 98% pass rate at A Level and 100% in BTEC
- 23% of all A Level grades were A and A*
- 31% of all BTEC grades were Distinction*
- 54% of last year's year 13 applied and secured university places (90% who applied got their first choice)
- Within that, 17% have gone to Russell Group and 3% to Oxbridge.
- Our five-year trend in results remains outstanding
- We want students to leave us as highly employable, well-rounded young people with a destination that is right for them.

Entry requirements

Entry criteria is as follows:

- APS (average GCSE points) of 3.7+
- To calculate APS, take your 8 best GCSEs, add them up and divide by 8 to give average points
- At least a grade 4 in English Language or Maths
- If you have English Language OR Maths but not both, you are required to re-sit the other
